### **Review of USA Track & Field's Rule 144.3(d) Determines Results Stand for Athlete Jerry Johncock**

MINNEAPOLIS, MN (October 8, 2009) – After review of USATF Rule 144.3(d), Twin Cities in Motion has determined that Jerry Johncock's unofficial results stand after it was brought to the attention of race officials that he stepped off the course to insert a catheter. Under Rule 144.3(d) it is not considered assistance.
