



## 2010 Corporate Team Challenge

Dear Runner:

This year marks the 2nd annual TC 10K and the 1<sup>st</sup> year of the TC 10K Corporate Team Challenge. This challenge offers companies an extraordinary opportunity to add some excitement, team building and good-natured competition to the work place. There will be an exclusive Corporate Team Challenge Tent at the capitol grounds where teammates can gather pre and post-race for refreshments and snacks. In addition, all participating companies and the winning individual team members will be recognized on the Twin Cities In Motion website.

The team criteria are simple: any corporation, profit or non-profit, and all employees, full or part-time, may participate. To qualify for fastest team, each corporate team must consist of a minimum of 5 full or part-time employees. Teams must also include one female and one masters runner (age 40 or older), but one person may fulfill both criteria. For example, a woman 40 or older would meet the team requirements.

First through third place teams will be recognized in the following two categories:

1. FASTEST (see attached sheet for rules and scoring formula), and
2. HIGHEST NUMBER of participants to complete the race

## 2010 Corporate Team Challenge

### TC 10K

#### Captain's Information

##### **Who can be a Corporate Team Challenge Captain?**

Anyone! Simply recruit co-workers to sign up for and run the TC 10K, on Oct. 2, 2010. To ensure your success as a team captain and a great experience for your entire team, please be prepared to fulfill the captain's responsibilities outlined below. In return, you will receive great support from the marathon office!

##### **Captain's Responsibilities:**

1. Team captains will ensure that the team creation is completed by September 17, 2010 ([www.mtcmarathon.org](http://www.mtcmarathon.org)). The team creation fee of \$35 will be processed at the time of registration using a credit card.
2. Team captains will ensure all team participants are individually registered online and have paid their individual registration fee of \$25.00 per person. Online registration opens February 2, 2010.
3. Team captains will be the contact person for all team members and the liaison to the marathon office.
4. Team captains will maintain contact with team members until race time.
5. Team captains will ensure all team participants are employees of company. Spouses, friends and family are not to join the team if they are not employed by company.
6. Team captains will advise team members that running under someone else's bib number/registration is not allowed, switching of team member's names is not possible. Individual registrants should check the online registration confirmation page at [www.mtcmarathon.org/SatEvents/registrationconfirmation](http://www.mtcmarathon.org/SatEvents/registrationconfirmation) to verify their registration.
7. Team captains are responsible for managing their team rosters online with all roster updates/changes finalized by September 24, 2010. Captains can make roster changes via the online captain's login provided at the time of team registration. Please note: team captains must include themselves on the team roster if they are running.
8. Team captains should relay information to team members on how and when to pick up their race packets. This information is also available online through the event website [www.mtcmarathon.org](http://www.mtcmarathon.org)
9. Team captains will instruct members on where to meet before and after the race. For your convenience we are providing an exclusive Corporate Team Challenge tent on the Capitol Grounds in Saint Paul.
10. Final review of team rosters will be completed by September 24, 2010 to ensure the roster is correct. No changes will be accepted after this date including race weekend.
11. After the race is completed and before any results will be sent out, team captains must verify each team member's race results to ensure accuracy of team final results. The marathon office will send final results to the team captains for verification.

##### **The marathon office will provide all Team Captains with:**

1. An online team management tool for creating, updating and reviewing rosters.
2. Information on where teams can meet before and after race.
3. Ideas to make this event a team building effort, such as recruiting and team training tips, creating team shirts, pre- and post-race team photo ops, post-race gatherings, etc.
4. The office will provide final results when they are official. (Usually 30 days after race)



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#### **Captain's Checklist**

##### **February-June**

- \_\_\_\_\_ Create your team by going to this link:  
<https://secure.marathonguide.com/register/TwinCitiesSaturday/> Team entry fee of \$35 will be processed with a credit card at that time. Team creation will be available on February 2.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Recruit employees from your company to run. (Post enclosed flyer to encourage participation.)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Encourage team members to complete their individual race registrations early. Online registration begins on February 1. Visit [www.mtcmarathon.org](http://www.mtcmarathon.org) for details. All team participants must be individually registered for the TC 10K and have paid their individual registration fees (\$25 per person).

##### **July-August**

- \_\_\_\_\_ Continue to recruit team members and encourage them to complete their individual online registrations.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Manage your team roster online (adding and/or deleting team members) using the team captain's login. Please ensure that all team members' names are spelled correctly.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Have participants check the Registration Confirmation on our website to verify their registration: [www.mtcmarathon.org/SatEvents/RegistrationConfirmation](http://www.mtcmarathon.org/SatEvents/RegistrationConfirmation)
- \_\_\_\_\_ Have your team run on one or both of the Saturdays that Twin Cities in Motion offers their summer water stops (July 17 and August 14 from 7:00 a.m.-10:00 a.m. at the Lake Calhoun Executive Center parking lot on the north end of Lake Calhoun). There will be water, PowerADE and camaraderie.
- \_\_\_\_\_ Encourage all employees and their families to participate in the TC 5K, TC 10K and Medtronic TC Family Events on Saturday, October 2, 2010, which include the Mile, Half Mile, Toddler Trot and Diaper Dash races, a Family Activities Tent and Harry and Shelly's Mascot Invitational.

- \_\_\_\_\_ Create company racing shirts for team members. (This is optional)

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#### TC 10K Competition Rules and Scoring Formula

**PURPOSE:** The purpose is to help build relationships, strengthen your team's work environment, and promote health and fitness.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Any corporation, profit or non-profit, may participate. All full-time and part-time employees are eligible.

#### Timed Competition

Each team will consist of a minimum of five employees, each of whom must be individually entered in the TC 10K. To qualify for the fastest team, at least one team member must be female, and one must be a masters runner (age 40 years or older). One female athlete age 40 or older can fulfill both requirements. Organizations may field as many qualified teams as they like, additional teams are required to pay the \$35 team fee.

**SCORING:** The company with the best cumulative total of its five fastest runners will win.

**AWARDS:** There are two awards categories:

1. A plaque will be awarded to the company with the greatest number of employees who register and finish.
2. A plaque will be awarded to the company with the best cumulative total of its five fastest runners. The five-member team must include one female and one Masters runner (age 40 or older).

The Corporate Team Challenge Plaque will be inscribed with the name of the winning team name and team member's names and remain in the team's possession.

**TEAM CREATION:** Complete the online creation process for forming a 10K corporate team at [www.mtcmarathon.org](http://www.mtcmarathon.org) by September 17. Team creation fee of \$35 will be processed at the time of registration using a credit card.

**FEES:** Each team member must pay the individual race entry fee of \$25. The team creation fee is \$35 per company. **All teams must be created by Sept. 17, 2010. Individuals can continue registering and be added to the team roster through Sept. 24, 2010.**

**RULES OF COMPETITION:** All teams and team members are required to follow the Rules of Competition outlined at [www.mtcmarathon.org](http://www.mtcmarathon.org).

6. Create a Login and Password and submit information
7. Login in to Team Tools and use the login and password you created.
8. Click on “Create Your First Team”
9. Complete the team captain information and submit credit card information. You will have successfully registered a Corporate Challenge Team.
